We meet once a month on the 3rd Wednesday
in the small room of the NRCC,
providing a 2 course lunch with coffee/tea and mints
for £4 per person.

For those unable to make their own way there
we also provide a free taxi service to collect and take them home.

We have a varied menu which always go down well and we ask for any
suggestions from the members.

All food is cooked on the premises (*NRCC kitchen*)
and is made with fresh, locally bought produce
and meat from Andrew, the village butcher, purchased on the morning.
We endeavour to create a restaurant atmosphere with waitress service.

Menus are advertised in advance and bookings taken
(*usually booked by the regulars from month to month*)
However, the maximum we can cater for is 24 owing to kitchen facilities.

Everyone enjoys both the food and company.
It is a purely non-profit making with any monies in excess of monthly costs
is saved to give the members a free Christmas Party Lunch.

It is an enjoyable 2 hours for both workers and diners.
