This view was refuted by all members as it has been previously agreed at the Full Council Meeting that the festival for 2019 would incorporate a music element, but would not be completely music based.

The newly appointed sub-committee members were met and Cllr Fraser Bateman welcomed Howard Cardus and Chris Manly to the sub-committee.
