- Sub-Committee are a good mixed group looking to support and protect places of interest, both historic and designated areas of importance, etc.
- Have good links with Norfolk Wildlife Trust
- Ability to work with Landowners on our behalf if necessary
- Consideration should be given in the NHP for additional housing (above suggested growth amount)
- Consideration should be given to mixed use allocation
- CCP will assist with writing the plan meeting our vision/objectives
- Areas of special protection identified/considered require assessments for environmental impact assessments arranged by CCP
- CCP have strong links with local planning, highways
- CCP willing to speak with landowners regarding restricted footpaths, planting trees if and when they are identified and processing accordingly
- CCP can assist with applying for grants/funding
- CCP will provide breakdown of their fees and forward
